

Algebra Preliminary Exam: Part II

Problem 1

Let p be an odd prime and \mathbb{F}_p denote the field with p elements.

- Let F be a finite extension of \mathbb{F}_p . Prove that the product of the non-zero elements of F equals -1 .
- Let ℓ be a prime. Determine the number of irreducible monic equations of degree ℓ over \mathbb{F}_p .

Problem 2

Let $\alpha = 1 + \sqrt[3]{2} + \sqrt[3]{4}$ and F be the Galois closure of $\mathbb{Q}(\alpha)$.

- Determine the minimal polynomial of α over \mathbb{Q} .
- Determine the Galois group $\text{Gal}(F/\mathbb{Q})$ as a permutation group.
- Determine all the intermediate fields of F/\mathbb{Q} .
- Determine a primitive generator of F/\mathbb{Q} .

Problem 3

Consider $f(x) = x^4 + 7x + 7$.

- Determine the degree of the splitting field of $f(x)$ over \mathbb{F}_3 .
- Let F be the splitting field of $f(x)$ over \mathbb{Q} . Prove that $\text{Gal}(F/\mathbb{Q}) \simeq \mathbf{S}_4$.

Recall: The discriminant of $x^n + ax + b$ is

$$(-1)^{n(n-1)/2}[(1-n)^{n-1}a^n + n^n b^{n-1}].$$
